

SOC Orientation Course

The SOC Orientation Course is required to be completed by all volunteers within Special Olympics Saskatchewan.

This online training is divided into four modules, followed by a knowledge check, to help orient you as a volunteer for Special Olympics Canada. Each module is designed to provide you with different information relating to the history and mission of Special Olympics, your role as a volunteer, an introduction to working with our athletes, and how to create safe and positive sport environments.


This course will take approximately 30 minutes to complete. The modules DO NOT have to be completed in one sitting so you are free to pause and return to the course at any time. You can also access the course again once you have completed it to review the information.

How to complete the SOC Orientation Course

- 1. Visit http://solearn.ca/login/index.php
 If you do not have an account, click the "Create New Account" button and follow the prompts. If you have an account, login.
- 2. Click on the "Orientation" heading that appears on the top of the homepage. It is right underneath "Start Here!"
- 3. Click on "Special Olympics Canada Volunteer Orientation."
- 4. Select either the "English Course" or the "Cours Français" depending on your preferred language.
- 5. Ensure "Normal" mode is selected and click "Enter"
- 6. Click "Access Module" to begin the course
- 7. Complete the modules by beginning with Overview and finishing with the Knowledge Check.
- 8. As you progress through the module, you will notice the border of the circle next to the module filling with red. Once you have completed each section it will show that you have completed it with a solid red circle with a white checkmark (see image below)





9. Once you pass the knowledge check, you will receive your Certificate of Completion via email. Please save this and send it to your local Special Olympics Community. You will also be able to go back and access this certificate after completing the course.
