

## **Saskatchewan LETR Outstanding Service Award**

This award will be presented annually to a Saskatchewan Law Enforcement Torch Run (LETR) volunteer that has exemplified the true meaning of the LETR mission. The nominee should be someone who contributes to LETR and Special Olympics Saskatchewan (SOS) in spirit, dedication and enthusiasm in an effective fashion.

### **NOMINATIONS**

Nominations are put forward to the Chair of the Provincial Board of Directors by the posted deadline prior to the Awards Ceremony. Anyone can put forth a nomination by the annual deadline date. The Chair of the Provincial Board of Directors will carefully review the nominations and select the recipient no later than two weeks prior to the Awards Ceremony. At the discretion of the SOS Board of Directors, nominations may be kept on file at SOS and considered in the year in which they are submitted, as well as the following 2 years. Every year, a representative of SOS will check with the nominators of any carryover nominations to see if they would still like the nomination to be considered. Please be advised that in order to maintain the integrity of this award, and the individual that it represents, the Saskatchewan LETR Outstanding Service Award will only be presented if the nominations submitted are deemed suitable by the Provincial Board of Directors. Therefore, this Award may not be issued annually.

### **AWARD CRITERIA**

The Saskatchewan LETR Outstanding Service Award is awarded to a Saskatchewan LETR volunteer who has shown outstanding dedication and contributions to LETR and Special Olympics Saskatchewan.

This award is intended to honor a Saskatchewan LETR volunteer who:

- Demonstrated an outstanding achievement in LETR development, organization or fundraising success.
- Is dedicated to the athletes, and committed to enhancing and improving their Special Olympics experience.
- Contributes to the Torch Run and Special Olympics in spirit, dedication and enthusiasm in an effective fashion.
- Is progressive in sustaining LETR in their respective community and across the Province.
- Has been involved with Saskatchewan LETR for a minimum of three years.

### **AWARD RECOGNITION**

- This award will be presented to the successful recipient at the Provincial Awards Banquet held annually.
- The recipient will be added to the Special Olympics Saskatchewan Recognition plaque.
- The recipient will receive a take-home plaque/award.
- The recipient may be highlighted and publicly recognized by Special Olympics Saskatchewan for their achievement(s). This may include such things as; postings on social media sites, newspaper/journal articles, community newsletters, etc.
