Nominations

Each Special Olympics PEI parent/guardian, athlete, coach or volunteer are encouraged to nominate coaches who they believe are worthy of receiving this award and who meets all the award criteria.

An ad-hoc subcommittee of the Special Olympics PEI Provincial Program Committee will carefully review the nominations, and from them select three finalists for both the Male and Female Coach of the Year Award, one of the three finalists being the winner.

Award Criteria

- The nominee must be an active registered volunteer with Special Olympics PEI.
- The nominee must be involved in Special Olympics program(s) throughout the year.
- The nominee must have attended a provincial qualifying event, national games or international games.
- The nominee must show leadership and be a good role model for fellow coaches/volunteers and athletes.
- The nominee must be committed to coach education and personal development.
