MEDICAL: Teams must always have a complete set of medical forms with them, for

athletes and coaches and provide to medical staff as needed. St. Johns Ambulance will be on site for the duration of the event.

COACH SIGN IN: All coaches will be required to sign in at the competition, bring their

NCCP#, and attend the complete competition.

The athlete to coach ratio for this competition is 4-1.

OFFICIATING: Time keepers will be volunteers.

DINNER AND DANCE: There will be a dinner and dance on Saturday January 25, 2025. Please

ensure that teams wishing to attend the dinner and dance, register for it, and arrive in Kelowna early enough to attend. The dinner will be at an additional cost, which we are currently working out with the Kelowna

Curling Club.

KELOWNA CUP: As this year we are doing a combination Curling/Snowshoeing Event,

there is a little twist. Points will be awarded for each ribbon an athlete receives (3 points for first, two points for second, and one point for third) in both the Snowshoe and Curling Events. At the end of the Snowshoe Competition on Sunday, the Local with the most points will

take home the Prestigious Kelowna Cup for the year.
